## Jim Cogdell of The Fork Stables

The 2004 Rolex Kentucky\*\*\*\* Event was my first. What a glorious spectacle this yearly event is—3 days of very hard riding, at the Olympic level—all of the who's who in Event riding were there. The colorful and arduous challenge starts with a steeplechase, then a stint in the dressage ring. The next day, the same horse and rider team run cross-country jumping over the most complicated and enormous jumps. On day 3, the team returns to the show ring for stadium jumping. A trial by any name. In '04 there were potential Olympians from across the world, each seeking to make his/her country's team.

It was there I literally ran into Jim Cogdell. A client who has commissioned a number of works from me—Jim is an extraordinary person. Native to North Carolina, he is founder and chair of the Charlotte real estate investment trust Cogdell Spencer, Inc. and an avid horseman and conservationist. The Fork land was once slated to become a development at the fork of Pee Dee and Rocky Rivers until Jim found it and stepped in to

protect the wildlife and create an enduring natural legacy on the 1300+ acres. He has built a state-of-the-art equestrian facility anchored by a 185 by 65 foot timber-framed barn with



15 stalls, a tackroom, veterinary lab and wonderful amenities for riders. Around this has been built one of the most beautiful cross county courses in the country (designed by Mark Phillips), plus dressage and jumping rings, miles of riding trails, wildlife refuge areas and camper facilities for visiting exhibitors. On one of the horse competition weekends, one can expect to see up to 2000 people and 400 horses there.
